I've lived, worked and campaigned in the East End for many years. I'm proud that the foundations of the labour movement and council housing were laid here and that we've opposed racism from Mosley's blackshirts till the present day.

I've been involved in campaigns including Save York Hall, Save Bethnal Green Library, Defend Council Housing

and the Stop the War Coalition. I formed United East End, an alliance of local people that stopped the English Defence League (EDL) stirring hatred in Tower Hamlets.
